AN ACT PLACING THE POSITIONS OF CUSTODIAN IN THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF AUBURN UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The position of custodian in the school department of the town of Auburn shall, upon the effective date of
 2 this act, become subject to the civil service laws and rules,
 3 and the tenure of office of any incumbent thereof shall be
 4 unlimited, subject, however, to such laws and rules; and the
 5 persons holding positions on said effective date shall continue
 6 to serve therein provided they pass qualifying examinations
 7 to which they shall be subjected by the division of civil service.
 8 Incumbents passing said qualifying examinations shall be certified for such position, and shall be deemed to be permanently
 9 appointed thereto without being required to serve any probationary period.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for acceptance to
 2 the voters of said town at the annual town meeting in the
 3 form of the following question, which shall be placed upon
 4 the official ballot to be used for the election of town officers
 5 at said meeting: — "Shall an act passed by the General Court
 6 in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-five, entitled 'An Act
 7 placing the positions of custodian in the school department of
 8 the town of Auburn under the civil service laws', be accepted?"
 9 If a majority of the votes in answer to said question is in the
 10 affirmative, this act shall take effect, but not otherwise.
