AN ACT

Relative to Compension of Clerks of Courts pro
Tempore.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph one of section thirty-
2 two of the Public Statutes is hereby amended by
3 striking out the words "by the clerk for whom
4 he is acting," and adding at the end of said para-
5 graph the words:—the same to be paid by the
6 clerk or the county, as the court may order,—
7 so that the paragraph will read as follows:—
8 Each clerk pro tempore shall be paid such
9 compensation as the court appointing him may
10 determine, the same to be paid by the clerk or by
11 the county, as the court may order.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
