

HOUSE No. 1818

By Mr. Connelly of Agawam (by request), petition of Charles Avezzi for legislation to prohibit turkey shoots from taking place within five hundred feet of a building used for dwelling purposes of a building housing farm animals. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

AN ACT PROHIBITING TURKEY SHOOTS FROM TAKING PLACE WITHIN FIVE HUNDRED FEET OF A BUILDING USED FOR DWELLING PURPOSES AND OR A BUILDING HOUSING FARM ANIMALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 58 of chapter 131 of the General Laws, as amended by
2 section 1 of chapter 802 of the acts of 1967, is hereby further
3 amended by adding at the end the following sentence: — A person
4 shall not conduct a turkey shoot within five hundred feet of a
5 dwelling house or a building used for housing farm animals.
