AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE DREDGING OF THE ANCHORAGE BASIN AT THE RESERVE CHANNEL, SO CALLED, AT SUMMER STREET, SOUTH BOSTON, IN THE IMMEDIATE VICINITY OF THE MILL YACHT CLUB, BY THE PORT OF BOSTON AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Port of Boston Authority is hereby authorized
2 and directed to dredge and enlarge the anchorage
3 basin at the Reserve channel, so called, at Summer
4 street, South Boston, in the immediate vicinity of
5 the Mill Yacht Club, to a depth of not less than nine
6 feet at mean low water, and may expend for such
7 purpose such sum or sums as may be hereafter
8 appropriated.
