

HOUSE No. 1308.

[Bill accompanying the petition of the town of Edgartown.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-six.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Edgartown to raise and appropriate Money for the Purpose of defraying the Expense of Additions and Improvements to the County Court House in said Town.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Edgartown may, at any
2 town meeting legally called and held, vote to raise or
3 borrow and may appropriate such sums of money as may
4 be necessary for the purpose of defraying the expense to
5 the county of all additions and improvements to the
6 county court house situated in said town which may be
7 ordered by the county commissioners or by the decree of
8 the supreme judicial court, and said town is hereby au-
9 thorized to expend such sums of money for said purpose.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
