AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE QUOTA OF BALLOTS FURNISHED EACH POLLING PLACE IN ELECTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section forty-five of chapter fifty-four of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first sen-
3 tence of said section and substituting therefor the
4 following: —

5 One ballot for every registered voter shall be pro-
6 vided for each polling place for which an election for
7 state, city or town officers is to be held.
