AN ACT

Authorizing the Cambridge Water Works to purchase the Property and Franchise of the Cambridgeport Aqueduct Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The Cambridge Water Works are hereby
2 authorized and empowered to purchase of the Cam-
3 bridgeport Aqueduct Company, all their corporate
4 property, both real and personal, together with the
5 franchise thereof, and the Cambridgeport Aqueduct
6 Company are hereby authorized and empowered to
7 sell and transfer all their corporate property, with the
8 franchise thereof, to the said Cambridge Water Works ;
9 and when said property shall have been purchased
10 and transferred as aforesaid, all the rights, powers and

11 privileges conferred upon the Cambridgeport Aque-
12 duct Company by their act of incorporation, with all
13 the duties, restrictions, and liabilities imposed by said
14 act, shall be vested in the Cambridge Water Works,
15 as fully and as legally as they now are in the Cam-
16 bridgeport Aqueduct Company.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
