### AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Attleborough to issue additional Water Supply Bonds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Attleborough, for  
2 the purposes mentioned in section four of chapter  
3 sixty-nine of the acts of the year eighteen hun-  
4 dred and ninety-three, and for the purpose of  
5 paying the necessary expenses and liabilities of  
6 the water department and the laying of water  
7 pipes, may issue bonds, notes or scrip, to be  
8 denominated on the face thereof, Attleborough

2 ATTLEBOROUGH WATER SUPPLY. [Jan. 1901.

9 Water Supply Bonds, 1901, to an amount not  
10 exceeding one hundred thousand dollars in addi-  
11 tion to the amount heretofore authorized by law  
12 to be issued by said town for the same purposes;  
13 said bonds, notes or scrip to be issued upon the  
14 same terms and conditions and with the same  
15 powers as are provided in said chapter sixty-nine  
16 for the issue of the Attleborough water supply  
17 bonds by said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 acceptance by the town of Attleborough.
