### AN ACT RELATIVE TO FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING FUNDS - PUBLIC LAW 92-512.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to  
2 the contrary, the investment of money received from the fed-  
3 eral government, pursuant to Public Law 92-512, as set forth in  
4 General Laws, chapter 44, section 55, as said statute relates to  
5 the investment of Revenue Cash, shall not constitute a barrier  
6 for borrowing in anticipation of revenue.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
