### AN ACT TO PROVIDE CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR CERTAIN LEAVES OF ABSENCES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Subdivision (1) of section 4 of chapter 32 of the General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by inserting after paragraph (O) the
- 3 following new paragraph: —
- 4 (P) Any member of a retirement system who is on leave of
- 5 absence without regular compensation for the purpose of per-
- 6 forming the official duties of a public employees union for a
- 7 period not to exceed twenty-four months may establish credit-
- 8 able service for such period of absence by depositing in the
- 9 annuity savings fund of the system of which he is a member an
- 10 amount equal to five percent of the compensation such mem-
- 11 ber would have received had he not taken said leave.
