## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES TO REIMBURSE CITIES AND TOWNS FOR TAXES LOST AS A RESULT OF THE ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN DWELLING HOUSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Any college or university, other than a college or university  
2 under public control, which acquires a dwelling house con-  
3 sisting of not more than three apartments, suites or family  
4 units shall reimburse the city or town in which such dwelling  
5 house is located for the taxes lost as a result of the acquisition.  
6 The assessors of the city or town affected shall on January first  
7 of each year determine the amount of taxes lost as a result of  
8 the acquisition.
