AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PROVISION OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE TO CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first paragraph of section 1 of chapter 472 of the Acts of  
2 1991 is hereby amended by inserting, in line 3, after the words  
3 "the town of Lee" the following comma and phrase: — ", in any  
4 city or town where no redevelopment authority has been organ-  
5 ized under the authority granted by section 4 of chapter 121B of  
6 the General Laws and no economic development and industrial  
7 corporation has been organized under the authority granted by  
8 section 3 of chapter 121C of the General Laws."
