**AN ACT TO PROVIDE COMPLETE AND ACCURATE RECORDS OF PROCEEDINGS
IN THE JURY-OF-SIX SESSIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 27A of Chapter 218 of the General Laws as most
2 recently amended by Chapter 371 of the Acts of 1984 is further
3 amended by striking out the fourth sentence of paragraph (h) and
4 inserting in place thereof the following: —

5 If the court is unable, for any reason, to provide a stenographer,
6 the proceedings may be recorded by electronic means upon the
7 filing of written assent by all parties to the proceedings.
