

**Chap. 136.** AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ACTION REQUIRED FOR THE PROTECTION OF CERTAIN FISHERIES IN INLAND WATERS BE ASSIGNED TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF WATER POLLUTION CONTROL.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Chapter 131 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 41, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 802 of the acts of 1967, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —

*Section 41.* If the director determines that any fisheries in the inland waters of the commonwealth are of sufficient value to warrant the prohibition or regulation of the discharge of any waste or other material from any source, which may, directly or indirectly, injure such fisheries, he may thereupon give written notice of such determination to the director of the division of water pollution control, who shall take appropriate action under the provisions of sections twenty-six to fifty-three, inclusive, of chapter twenty-one.

**Chap. 137.** AN ACT REQUIRING COMMON CARRIERS, RAILWAYS AND RAILROAD COMPANIES TO SUBMIT EVIDENCE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES RELATIVE TO THEIR COMPLIANCE WITH CERTAIN DEPARTMENT ORDERS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 16 of chapter 159 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following two sentences: — Every such common carrier, railroad or railway company shall submit evidence to the department within thirty days after such order is served upon it that it has complied, or is in the process of complying, with such order. The two preceding sentences shall not be applicable to any particular order issued under this section pending any appeal from such order.

**Chap. 138.** AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE WORD "MOTOR CYCLE".

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 1 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the definition of "Motor cycle", as amended by section 1 of chapter 85 of the acts of 1965, and inserting in place thereof the following definition: — "Motor cycle", any motor vehicle having a seat or saddle for the use of the rider and designed to travel on not more than three wheels in contact with the ground, including any bicycle with a motor or driving wheel attached, except a tractor or a motor vehicle designed for the carrying of golf clubs and not more than four persons, an industrial three-wheel truck, or a motor vehicle on which the operator and passengers ride within an enclosed cab.
