[To accompany the petition of A. Dudley Bagley that the city of Boston may be authorized to construct a bridge over Chelsea creek. Cities.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Three.

AN ACT

To provide for the Construction of a Bridge over Chelsea Creek.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston shall construct
2 a bridge over Chelsea creek, from that part of
3 Boston known as Orient Heights to a point at or
4 near the vicinity of Webster avenue in the city
5 of Chelsea, at an expense not exceeding one hun-
6 dred and seventy-five thousand dollars. The cost
7 shall be paid by the county of Suffolk, and the
8 bridge shall be constructed under the direction of
9 the city engineer of the city of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. The said county commissioners
2 are hereby authorized to issue bonds of the county
3 to an amount not exceeding the said one hundred
4 and seventy-five thousand dollars, upon such
5 terms and in such form as the city treasurer of the
6 city of Boston shall determine.

1 SECTION 3. The county of Suffolk shall annu-
2 ally raise by taxation such sums as will be
3 sufficient, with the interest thereon, to pay the
4 interest on the said loans and the principal as it
5 becomes due.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
