## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE DISPOSAL OF REFUSE, RUBBISH OR SILT ON THE BANKS OF THE NEPONSET RIVER IN THE CITY OF BOSTON AND THE TOWN OF MILTON FROM THE GRANITE AVENUE BRIDGE TO THE CENTRAL AVENUE BRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Whoever disposes of refuse, rubbish or silt  
2 on either bank of the Neponset river in the city of Boston  
3 and the town of Milton, in any area from the center of the  
4 channel of said river to fifty yards above the high water  
5 mark between the Granite avenue bridge and the Central  
6 avenue bridge, shall be punished by a fine of five hundred  
7 dollars or imprisonment for one year or both.

1 SECTION 2. This land shall not be taken by eminent  
2 domain by any city or town, or sold to any private concern,  
3 to be used for the disposal of refuse, rubbish or silt, or for  
4 the building of an incinerator thereon.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
