In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

Resolve providing for Additional Band Concerts during the Current Year in Commemoration of the Tercentenary Celebrations in Places under the Control of the Metropolitan District Commission.

1 *Resolved*, That the metropolitan district commis-  
2 sion, in commemoration of tercentenary celebrations,  
3 is hereby authorized and directed to provide band  
4 concerts in such parks, parkways or other places  
5 under its control, and at such times during the  
6 current year as it may select. For the purposes of  
7 this resolve, said commission may expend such sum  
8 not exceeding five thousand dollars as may hereafter  
9 be appropriated, the same to be in addition to any  
10 other appropriations made for band concerts.
