## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

### AN ACT REQUIRING TAX ASSESSORS TO FURNISH WITH TAX BILLS, INFORMATION REGARDING ABATEMENTS AND VALUATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 86 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 86A.* The assessors shall mail, together with the
- 4 annual notice or bill of taxes levied upon real property, a
- 5 statement of the criteria used in making valuations upon said
- 6 property, and a list of abatements of taxes for which application
- 7 may be made and an explanation of the eligibility for each such
- 8 abatement.
