AN ACT TRANSFERRING JOSEPH J. MAGUIRE, AMBULANCE DRIVER OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF WATERTOWN, TO THE RANK OF REGULAR OFFICER OF SAID DEPARTMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Joseph J. Maguire, ambulance driver of the police
2 department of the town of Watertown, is hereby made a regular
3 officer of said police department without further examination,
4 shall continue to perform the duties of a driver as aforesaid, and
5 shall hereafter be entitled to all the benefits and protection of
6 the civil service laws, and the rules and regulations made there-
7 under, relative to such officer.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the town of Watertown.
