### RESOLVE

To provide for the Appointment of Commissioners to prepare Testimonials for the Soldiers and Sailors who served in the War with Spain.

1     *Resolved*, That the governor appoint a suitable person,  
2 and that the person so appointed and the lieutenant-gov-  
3 ernor and the adjutant-general, be commissioners, with-  
4 out pay, to cause to be engraved and printed a suitable  
5 testimonial for each officer, soldier or sailor who served  
6 on the quota of Massachusetts during the war with Spain,  
7 and was honorably discharged therefrom, or died in the  
8 service; and that the adjutant-general deliver such testi-  
9 monials, on application, to such persons as he may deem  
10 entitled to receive the same.
