AN ACT FURTHER ESTABLISHING THE RIGHTS OF PARTIES
TO CERTAIN CONTRACTS FOR INSURANCE ON MOTOR
VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 113D of chapter 175 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—
3 The insurance carrier may request the insured to
4 present his car upon reasonable notice for examination
5 by a qualified examiner, designated by the insurance
6 carrier for the purpose of determining the condition of
7 said motor vehicle covered by the insurance policy.
8 Failure of the insured to co-operate with the examiner
9 for the purpose of inspection shall be grounds for
10 cancellation of the policy of insurance upon notice as
11 herein described in the preceding sections.
