AN ACT TO FURTHER REGULATE MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE RATE CLASSIFICATION APPLICABLE TO PERSONS AGE SIXTY-FIVE OR OLDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 4 of chapter 15E of the General Laws as appearing in
- 2 the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 word "classification" in line 51 the following words: — provided
- 4 however that such twenty-five percent reduction shall apply
- 5 whether or not an operator other than insured is listed on the
- 6 policy of insurance.
