## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

### AN ACT TO CHANGE COUNTY BOARD VOTER REQUIREMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 35 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by striking  
2 out the first sentence of Section 28B(a) and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following: —

4 (a) In every county other than Suffolk and Nantucket, there  
5 shall be an advisory board on county expenditures consisting of  
6 the city manager or his designee, who must be a member of the  
7 city council or board of aldermen or a salaried municipal official  
8 in a Plan D or Plan E city, or the mayor or his designee, who must  
9 be a member of the city council or board of aldermen or a salaried  
10 municipal official in each city, or any member of the board of  
11 selectmen of each town or a salaried municipal official of each  
12 such town appointed by the Chairman of the board of selectmen or  
13 any member of the town council or a salaried municipal official  
14 appointed by the chairman of the town council of such town in a  
15 town that does not have selectmen.
