AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE STATUS OF FRANK WHITE AS A MEMBER OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Frank White, a member of the fire
2 department of the city of Boston, who was injured
3 in the performance of duty as a military substitute
4 in said department, shall be deemed to be permanently
5 appointed thereto without further examination and
6 without being required to serve any probationary
7 period.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
