
By Mr. Hennigan (by request), petition of Joseph P. McNamara that provision be made for a larger appropriation for the finance commission of the city of Boston. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE A LARGER APPROPRIATION FOR THE FINANCE
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 20 of chapter 486 of the acts of 1909, as most re-
2 cently amended by chapter 175 of the acts of 1948, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out, in line 6 and in line 10, the
4 word "fifty-five" and inserting in place thereof in each in-
5 stance, the word: — sixty-five, — so as to read as follows: —
6 *Section 20.* The said commission is authorized to employ such
7 experts, counsel, and other assistants, and to incur such other
8 expenses as it may deem necessary, and the same shall be paid
9 by said city upon requisition by the commission, not exceeding
10 in the aggregate in any year the sum of sixty-five thousand
11 dollars, or such additional sums as may be appropriated for
12 the purpose by the city council and approved by the mayor.
13 A sum sufficient to cover the salary of the chairman of the
14 commission and the further sum of at least sixty-five thousand
15 dollars to meet the expenses as aforesaid each year shall be
16 appropriated by said city. The commission shall have the same
17 right to incur expenses in anticipation of its appropriation as
18 if it were a regular department of said city.
