AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ANALYSIS OF NARCOTIC DRUGS, POISON, DRUGS, MEDICINES OR CHEMICALS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS MEDICAL SCHOOL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 36B of Chapter 75, as most recently amended by
- 2 section 1 of chapter 700 of the acts of 1981, is hereby further
- 3 amended by striking out the words "without charge."
