RESOLVE.

Providing for Finishing and Furnishing the New Dormitory
at the State Normal School at Worcester.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding six
3 thousand dollars, to be expended at the state normal
4 school at Worcester, under the direction of the state
5 board of education for the purpose of finishing and
6 furnishing the new dormitory at said school, the building
7 of which was authorized by chapter ninety-three of the
8 resolves of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one.
9 The above sum is to include all expenses necessary to
10 get the building ready for occupancy and to properly
11 grade the grounds.
