

SENATE No. 258.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

[Senate, No. 230, as amended.]

AN ACT

In addition to an Act to regulate the sale of Intoxicating Liquors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The election required by section three of
2 chapter one hundred and forty-one of the acts of the
3 year eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled an
4 Act to regulate the sale of Intoxicating Liquors, to
5 be held on the third Tuesday of May, shall be held

6 on the first Tuesday of June of the current year, any-
7 thing in said act to the contrary notwithstanding.

1 SECT. 2. The county commissioners of the several
2 counties shall receive in addition to their present
3 salaries at the rate of five dollars per day, for each and
4 every day when engaged as license commissioners
5 under said chapter one hundred and forty-one of said
6 acts of the current year, to be paid from the county
7 treasury.

1 SECT. 3. The sixth section of the act referred to
2 in the first section of this act is hereby amended by
3 striking out "third Monday of May" and inserting
4 "first Tuesday in June."

1 SECT. 4. The fourth clause of the fourth section of
2 the act referred to in the first section of this act is
3 hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 5. Sections four, sixteen and eighteen of
2 said chapter one hundred and forty-one, are hereby so
3 far amended that in the sentences therein provided,
4 the court may inflict the punishment of imprisonment
5 without the fine, or fine without imprisonment, or
6 both, at its discretion.

1 SECT. 6. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
