AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE SCHOOL COMMITTEE OF THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD AWARD CONCESSIONS IN CERTAIN FIELDS TO THE HIGHEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the school
- 2 committee of the city of New Bedford shall award concessions
- 3 for food at any field under its control to only the highest re-
- 4 sponsible bidders.
