AN ACT AUTHORIZING CERTAIN LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES TO PROVIDE ADULT DAY CARE SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A long-term care facility shall be authorized to
2 provide adult day care services by certificate issued by the
3 Department of Public Health.

1 SECTION 2. The Department of Public Health shall establish
2 regulations, requirements and procedure for certifying long-term
3 care facilities authorized to provide adult day care services,
4 including but not limited to dietary, recreational and social
5 services.
