AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TIME WITHIN WHICH COUNTIES, CITIES, TOWNS AND DISTRICTS MAY INCUR DEBT TO SECURE THE BENEFITS PROVIDED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO ASSIST THEM IN PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would
2 tend to defeat its purpose, which is to make available
3 without interruption to counties, cities, towns and dis-
4 tricts financial assistance by the federal government
5 for public works projects, therefore it is hereby declared
6 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate
7 preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of chapter 74 of the acts of 1945, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 173 of the acts of 1953,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 4, the
4 word "fifty-five" and inserting in place thereof the
5 word:— fifty-seven,— so as to read as follows:—
6 *Section 6.* Loans by counties, cities, towns and dis-
7 tricts may be authorized under the provisions of this
8 act until July first, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.
