## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE JUSTICE OF THE THIRD DISTRICT COURT OF ESSEX AND PROVIDING THAT HE SHALL DEVOTE FULL TIME TO HIS JUDICIAL DUTIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 77A of chapter 218  
2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the  
3 line reading "central district court of northern Essex", as ap-  
4 pearing in section 1 of chapter 675 of the acts of 1958, the follow-  
5 ing line: — third district court of Essex.

1 SECTION 2. Section 78 of said chapter 218 is hereby amended  
2 by striking out the words "third district court of Essex" in the  
3 third sentence as appearing in section 2 of said chapter 675.

By the House of Representatives, passed in the House of Representatives on the 15th day of June, 1907, and in the Senate on the 17th day of June, 1907, with amendments, and approved on the 17th day of June, 1907.

### The Communications of Congress

In the Year 1907, and in the Year 1908.

The first communication from the President of the United States to the House of Representatives, in the year 1907, was the annual message, delivered on the 3rd day of January, 1907.

It is contained in the Senate and House of Representatives, in the report of the Secretary of the Senate, and in the report of the Secretary of the House of Representatives.

Section 1. The first paragraph of section 1701 of the Revised Statutes of the United States is hereby amended by striking out the words "and the words 'third district' shall be inserted in the third paragraph of section 1701 of the Revised Statutes of the United States."

Section 2. Section 1701 of and chapter 218 is hereby amended by striking out the words "third district" in the third paragraph of section 1701 of said chapter 218.
