1 *Ordered, That* The committee on Health Care be author-  
2 ized to sit during the recess of the general court for the pur-  
3 pose of making an investigation and study of the subject of the  
4 current Senate document numbered: — 615, legislation to re-  
5 organize the Board of Registration in Medicine.

6 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in or else-  
7 where, may hold public hearings, may travel within the com-  
8 monwealth, and may expend for clerical and other services  
9 and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefore.  
10 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results  
11 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,  
12 together with drafts of such legislation necessary to carry  
13 such recommendations into effect by filing the same with the  
14 clerk of the House on or before the first Wednesday of De-  
15 cember, nineteen hundred and eighty-four.
