AN ACT

To amend the Certificate of Incorporation of the Supreme Council of the Home Circle.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECTION 1. The certificate of incorporation of the
2 supreme council of the Home Circle, dated the thir-
3 teenth day of January eighteen hundred and eighty,
4 is hereby amended so that the purpose therein ex-
5 pressed shall read as follows : —

6 “For the purpose of organizing and uniting in
7 fraternal union all acceptable members of the order
8 known as the Royal Arcanum, their friends, wives,
9 mothers, sisters, and daughters ; to aid and assist its
10 members and educate them socially, morally, and
11 intellectually ; to establish a benefit fund from which,
12 on the satisfactory evidence of the death of a mem-
13 ber, who has complied with its lawful requirements,

14 a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars shall be
15 paid to the family, orphans, or dependents, as the
16 member shall have directed.”

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
