AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE SOUTH POND BEACH, SO CALLED, IN THE TOWN OF SAVOY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of natural resources
2 is hereby authorized and directed to develop for park,
3 beach and other recreational purposes the beach and
4 camp facilities at South pond in the Savoy State forest
5 in the town of Savoy. The department is authorized
6 to improve the said beach, construct bathhouses,
7 make available more space for parking purposes, and
8 to provide picnic and camping sites and a roadway to
9 the main highways.

1 SECTION 2. For the cost of such construction, re-
2 pair and improvements said department may expend
3 such sums as may be hereafter appropriated therefor.
