## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-One.

AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN PERSONS ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION TO AND TREATMENT AT THE SOLDIERS' HOME IN MASSACHUSETTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Persons who were in the service of the United  
2 States in any branch of the military or naval forces  
3 thereof, and who enlisted from this commonwealth  
4 or have since acquired a settlement therein, who were  
5 called upon and were engaged in any campaign that  
6 has been recognized by the Congress of the United  
7 States, and received an honorable discharge from such  
8 service shall be eligible for admission to and treatment  
9 at the Massachusetts Soldiers' Home to the same  
10 extent as veterans of the world war and of the Mexi-  
11 can border uprising.
