

In Middlesex county the assistant clerk shall receive a sum equal to eighty per cent of the salary of the clerk. In all counties other than Middlesex and Suffolk the assistant clerk shall receive a sum equal to seventy-five per cent of the salary of the clerk, and in all counties other than Suffolk the second assistant clerk shall receive a sum equivalent to sixty per cent of the salary of the clerk and all other assistant clerks shall receive a sum equivalent to fifty-five per cent of the salary of the clerk.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January first, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight. *Approved April 30, 1968.*

Chap. 210. AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXTENDING THE TERM OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE OF THE SAVINGS BANK INVESTMENT FUND.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 283 of the acts of 1945 is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — The directors for the time being of the Mutual Savings Central Fund, Inc., established by chapter forty-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-two, as amended, hereinafter called the incorporators, are hereby constituted a corporation for a term ending upon the dissolution of the said Mutual Savings Central Fund, Inc. under the name of the Savings Bank Investment Fund, hereinafter referred to as the corporation. *Approved April 30, 1968.*

Chap. 211. AN ACT EXTENDING DEATH BENEFITS TO GRANDCHILDREN OF DECEASED MEMBERS OF THE GRAND LODGE OF MASSACHUSETTS OF THE INDEPENDENT ORDER SONS OF ITALY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 129 of the acts of 1938, as appearing in chapter 138 of the acts of 1956, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 8, the words "families or dependents" and inserting in place thereof the words: — families, dependents or grandchildren. *Approved April 30, 1968.*

Chap. 212. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE QUALIFICATION FOR VOTING FOR ELECTORS FOR THE OFFICE OF PRESIDENT AND VICE-PRESIDENT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The second sentence of section 26 of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 7 of chapter 437 of the acts of 1962, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 4, the word "thirty-second" and inserting in place thereof the word: — thirty-first. *Approved April 30, 1968.*
