AN ACT

Relative to the Regulation of Sewer Assessments in the
City of Newton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The mayor and aldermen of the city of
2 Newton are hereby authorized to amend, repeal or re-
3 scind any or all existing orders or ordinances of the city
4 of Newton which establish a method of sewer assessment,
5 and by which any assessments for sewers have been
6 made; and the city is further authorized to adopt and
7 establish by ordinance or by order, any method of sewer
8 assessment now authorized by law, and to make by its
9 board of aldermen, with the approval of the mayor, as-
10 sessments and reassessments thereunder, provided that
11 no change shall be made in assessments already levied
12 at the time of the passage of this act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
