AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Maintenance of the State Infirmary.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding four hundred
2 and eighteen thousand dollars is hereby appro-
3 priated to be paid out of the treasury of the com-
4 monwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the
5 maintenance of the state infirmary for the fiscal
6 year ending on the thirtieth day of November,
7 nineteen hundred and twelve. (Rev. Laws, ch. 85;
8 Acts 1909, ch. 504, sect. 98.)

(Appropriation 1911, \$394,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
