**AN ACT PROVIDING FOR REDUCTIONS IN THE TAXATION OF SAVINGS  
ACCOUNTS OF PERSONS AGE SIXTY-FIVE AND OVER.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Clause (6) subdivision (a) of subsection B of section 3 of  
2 chapter 62 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inser-  
3 ting after the words "Part B Gross Income", the following  
4 sentence: — A deduction from Part B income, in addition to  
5 that provided by the first sentence of this clause, of two hun-  
6 dred dollars on income from savings deposits, savings ac-  
7 counts, shares or share savings accounts for persons age sixty-  
8 five and older. For married couples age sixty-five or older this  
9 additional deduction shall be in the amount of four hundred  
10 dollars.
