AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF WITNESS FEES TO CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS IN CRIMINAL CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 53 of chapter 262 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 455 of the acts of
3 1949, is hereby further amended by striking out the
4 first sentence and inserting in place thereof the follow-
5 ing sentence:— Any police officer on vacation, fur-
6 lough or on a day off, who attends as a witness or as an
7 arresting officer in a criminal case pending in a dis-
8 trict court, including the municipal court of the city
9 of Boston, or before a trial justice, shall be allowed
10 a witness fee in the amount of three dollars for each
11 day's attendance.
