AN ACT

Relative to the Qualification of Witnesses.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 No person convicted of the crime of simple larceny,
2 before any police court, or any justice of the peace, in
3 this Commonwealth, shall, by reason of such convic-
4 tion, be disqualified from testifying in any court of
5 justice, or elsewhere.
