1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Natural Resources be au-
2 thorized to sit during the recess of the general court for the pur-
3 pose of making an investigation and study of the subject matter
4 of current house document numbered 1834, requiring hunting
5 licenses to include statement of past mental competence.

6 Said commission shall be provided with quarters in the state
7 house or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel within
8 the commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other serv-
9 ices and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
10 Said commission shall report to the general court the results of
11 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
12 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
13 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of
14 the house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday of
15 December, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
