AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE LAW RELATING TO THE RETIREMENT OF STATE POLICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subdivision 2 (b) of section 26 of
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended
3 by striking out clause (i).

1 SECTION 2. Said subdivision 2 (b) is hereby fur-
2 ther amended by striking out clause (ii) and inserting
3 in place thereof the following: — (ii) a yearly amount
4 of pension equal to one half of the annual rate of his
5 regular compensation on the date such illness or in-
6 jury was incurred or equal to one half of the average
7 annual rate of his regular compensation for the twelve
8 months' period for which he last received regular
9 compensation immediately preceding the date his re-
10 tirement allowance becomes effective, whichever is
11 the greater.

The House of Representatives of the United States of America, in session assembled, do hereby pass the following resolution:

RESOLUTION

That the Secretary of the Interior be and he is hereby authorized to

execute such orders and do such things as may be necessary and proper to carry out the purposes of this resolution.
