The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE BOARD OF STATE EXAMINERS OF ELECTRICIANS, TO PROMULGATE CERTAIN PROCEDURES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary,  
2 the Board of State Examiners of electricians is hereby author-  
3 ized and directed to give oral, rather than written exams upon  
4 request of those individuals who do not possess an adequate  
5 mastery of the English language to permit them to take the  
6 written exam in English. Furthermore said oral exam shall  
7 be given in the applicant's native language.
