2 to sit during the recess of the General Court to make an
3 investigation and study of House documents 224 and 1012, relative
4 to certain traffic assignments. Said committee shall report to the
5 General Court the results of its investigation and study and its
6 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation
7 necessary to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing the
8 same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or before
9 the last Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and ninety-
