AN ACT

Relative to the President of the Board of Aldermen
of the City of Newburyport.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hun-
2 dred and one of the acts of the year eighteen
3 hundred and ninety-nine is hereby amended by
4 by inserting after the word "member," in the
5 sixth line, the words:— and president; and also
6 by adding at the end thereof the following:— In
7 case, however, of the death, absence or disability
8 of the president the board of aldermen may choose
9 a president pro tempore,— so as to read as fol-
10 lows:—

11 *Section 1.* The qualified voters of the city of

12 Newburyport at each annual municipal election
13 shall elect, in addition to the six aldermen pro-
14 vided for by chapter eighty-six of the acts of the
15 year eighteen hundred and sixty-four, some quali-
16 fied voter of said city, whose title shall be alder-
17 man at large, and who shall be a member and
18 president of the board of aldermen. In case,
19 however, of the death, absence or disability of
20 the president, the board of aldermen may choose
21 a president pro tempore.

1 SECTION 2. Section two of chapter one hun-
2 dred and one of the acts of the year eighteen
3 hundred and ninety-nine is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall be submitted to the
2 voters of the city at the next annual state election;
3 and shall take effect upon its acceptance by a
4 majority of the voters voting thereon.
