AN ACT REQUIRING THE TOWN OF WEST SPRINGFIELD TO PAY TO THE TOWN OF SOUTHWICK CERTAIN COSTS AND EXPENSES OF ENGINEERING STUDIES FOR THE PREVENTION OF POLLUTION OF CERTAIN WELLS USED BY SAID TOWN OF WEST SPRINGFIELD AND LOCATED IN SAID TOWN OF SOUTHWICK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. As a condition to the use of wells and the taking  
2 of water from underground sources within the town of  
3 Southwick by the town of West Springfield, limited, however,  
4 to a maximum of three and one half million gallons in any  
5 day, the town of West Springfield shall pay to the town of  
6 Southwick all costs and expenses of any nature incurred by  
7 the town of Southwick in connection with engineering stud-  
8 ies, installation and maintenance of sanitary sewer system  
9 and waste disposal system in order to prevent the possibility  
10 of any future source of pollution to the aforesaid wells used  
11 by the town of West Springfield.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
