SIR: The Board of Registration in Embalming respectfully submits the following as its annual report for the year ending November 30, 1929.

The Board as organized; James H. Quinn, Chairman; Osborne F. Briggs, Secretary; Willard P. Staples, member.

During the year there have been 7 meetings, also 2 regular examinations to qualify applicants to practice embalming within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

There appeared at the March examination 61 applicants, 2 being applicants for re-examination; at the October examination there were 66 applicants, 2 being applicants for re-examination. There were 43 registered embalmers paid a fee of \$12. (Acts of 1921, Chap. 419).
