RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH RELATIVE TO MEANS AND METHODS OF REMEDYING THE POLLUTION OF MARTIN'S POND IN THE TOWN OF NORTH READING.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public health is
2 hereby authorized and directed to investigate and
3 study the best and most feasible means and methods
4 of remedying the pollution of Martin's pond in the
5 town of North Reading. Said department shall
6 report to the general court the results of its investiga-
7 tion and study and its recommendations, including
8 estimates of cost and drafts of legislation necessary
9 to carry said recommendations into effect, by filing
10 the same with the clerk of the house of representatives
11 on or before the first Wednesday of December in the
12 year nineteen hundred and forty.
